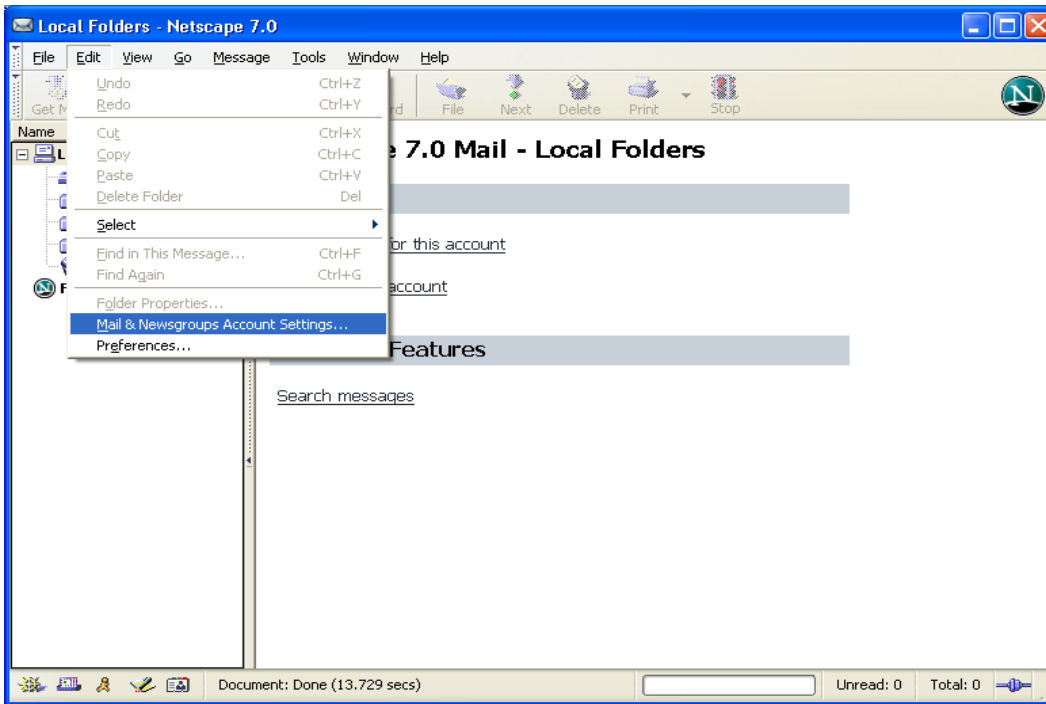


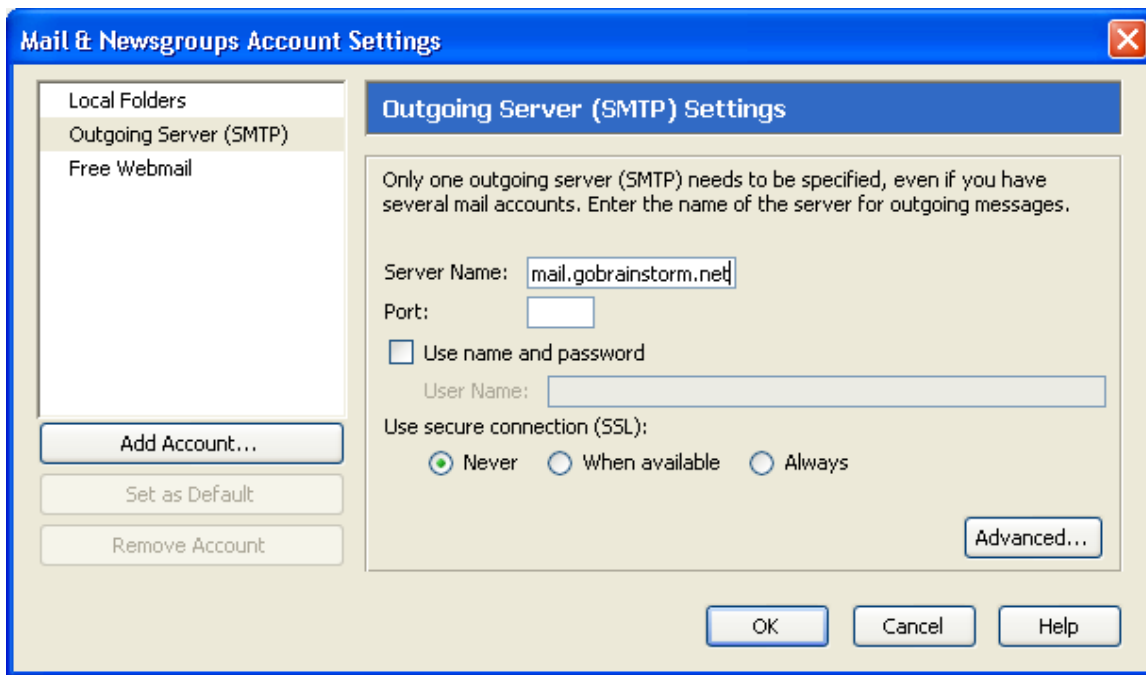
- 1.) Open Netscape navigator 7.0
- 2.) Go into Netscape Mail.
- 3.) Click **Edit**.
- 4.) Go to **Mail & Newsgroups Account Settings....**



5.) Remove all accounts until your screen looks like this one below.

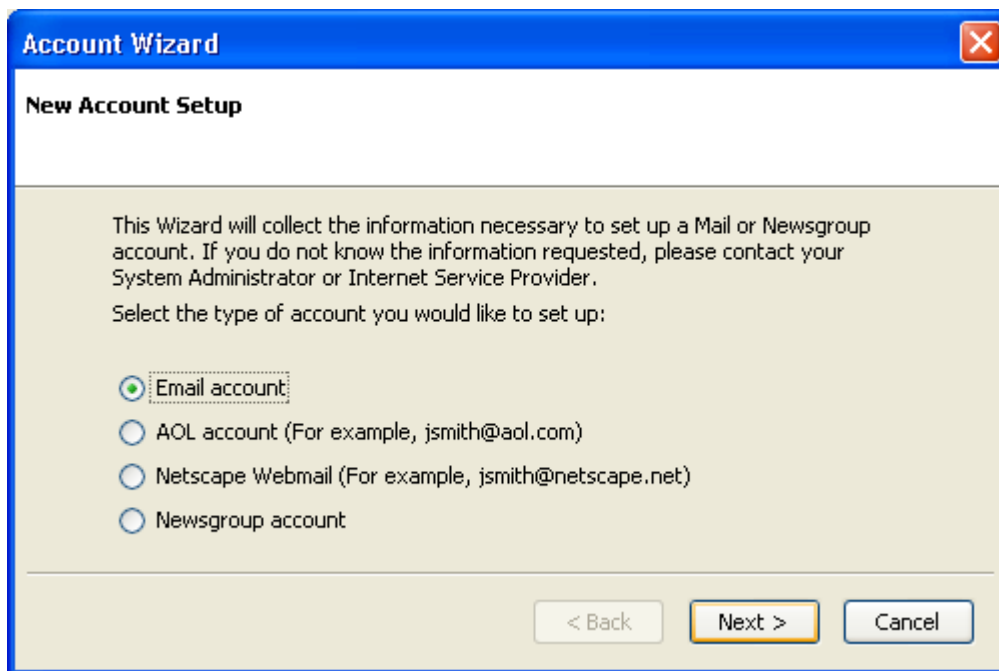
Only choices you should have is (**Local Folders, Outgoing Server, Free Webmail**)

- 6.) Click on the **Outgoing Server (SMTP)** in the Server Name type **mail.gobrainstorm.net**, then **Uncheck Use name and password**
- 7.) Click **OK**
- 8.) **Repeat steps 1 thru 4.**
- 9.) Now on the left hand side bottom **CLICK: Add Account....**



10.) Click **Email Account**.

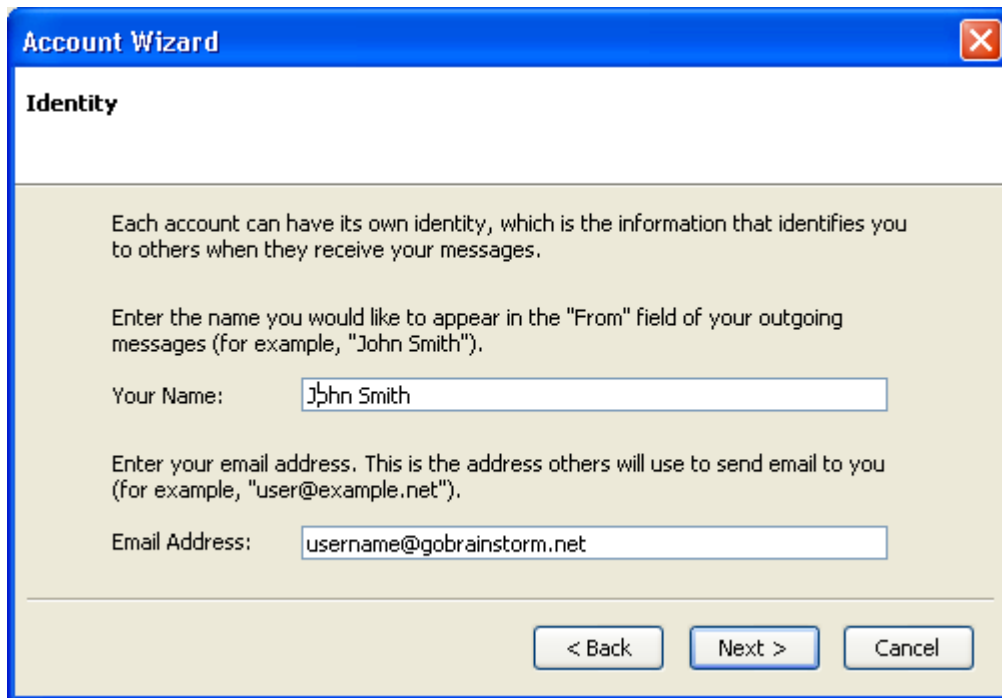
11.) Click **Next >**



12.) Type in **Your Name** in the top box, example. "**JOHN SMITH**"

13.) Type in your email address: [username@gobrainstorm.net](mailto:username@gobrainstorm.net)

14.) Click **Next**

### Identity

Each account can have its own identity, which is the information that identifies you to others when they receive your messages.

Enter the name you would like to appear in the "From" field of your outgoing messages (for example, "John Smith").

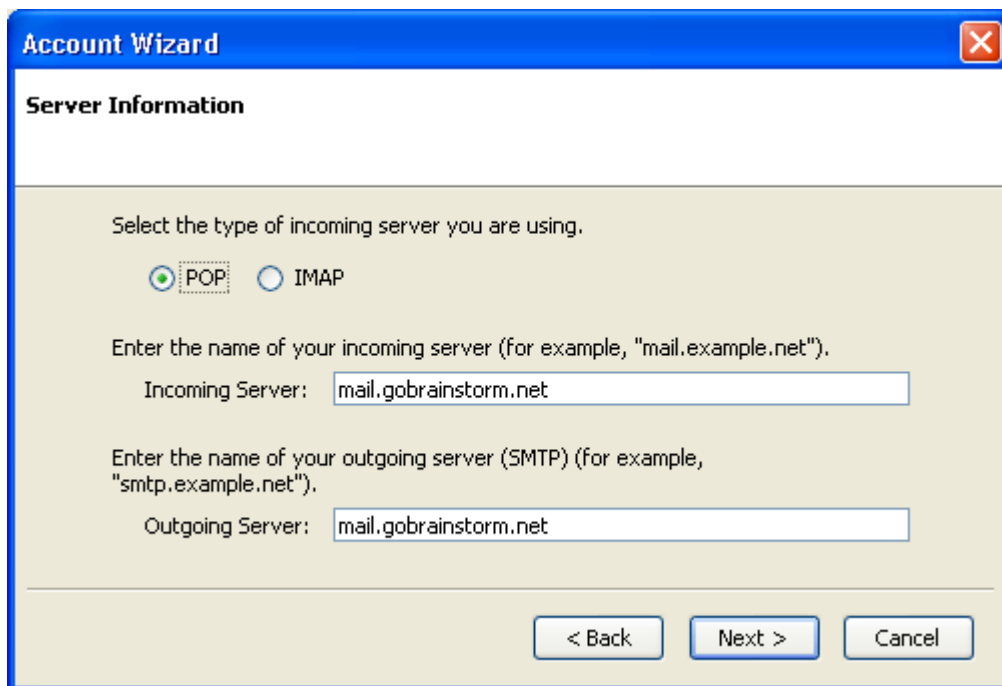

- 15.) Click **POP**
- 16.) Type in the Incoming Server: **mail.gobrainstorm.net**
- 17.) Type in the Outgoing Server: **mail.gobrainstorm.net** (if it asks you for one)
- 18.) Click **Next >**

Incoming Server:

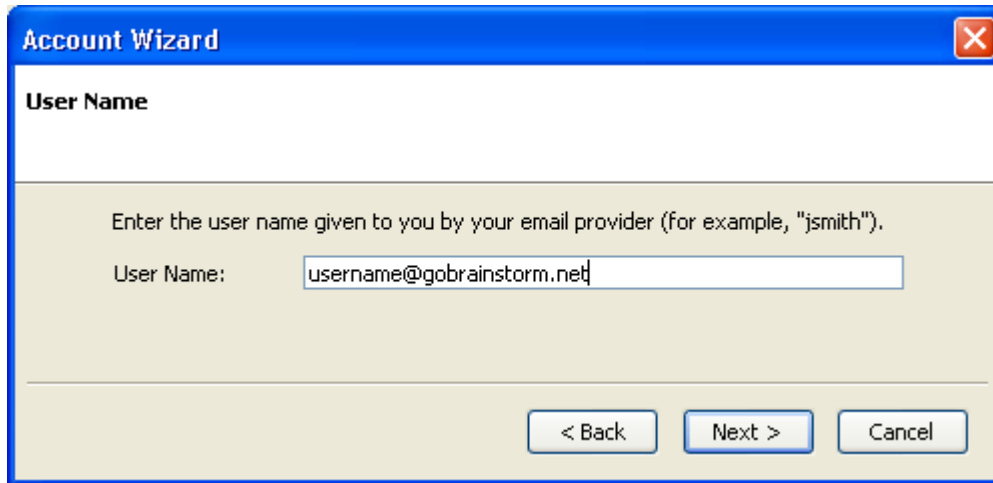
Enter the name of your outgoing server (SMTP) (for example, "smtp.example.net").

19.) **Type** in your email address.

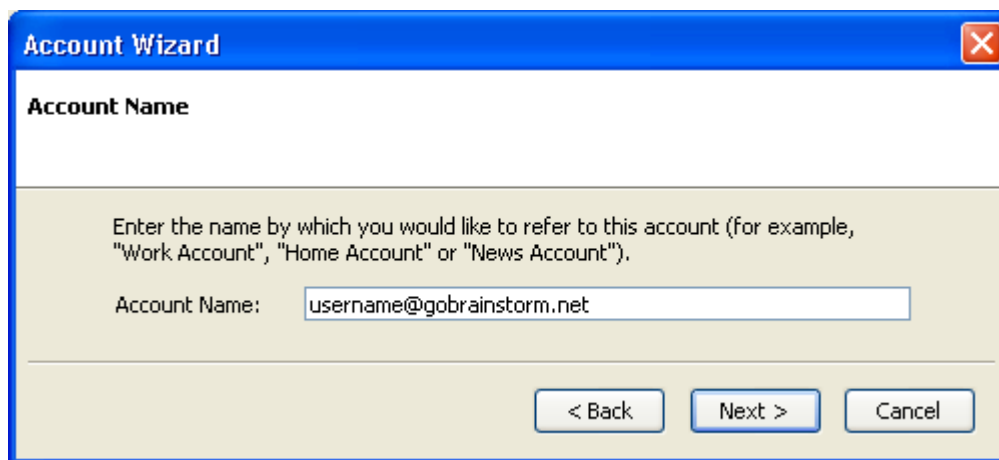
20.) Click **Next >**
